Dear Unity on the Avenue Members and Friends:

Thank you for joining us as we launch our “Ask and It Is Given” Stewardship Campaign. We are asking for your pledges to support Unity on the Avenue Spiritual Center over the next fiscal year, from January 1, 2022, to December 31, 2022. Thank you for prayerfully considering the amount you give.

A global pandemic, coupled with changes in religious commitment in society, mean that congregants are a bit more responsible for making sure their giving is enough to keep their religious institutions thriving and making a difference. Add in tax changes that lessen attention to charitable giving, and your support is even more essential. The stewardship campaign, taking place from November 7 through November 28, is how we set our annual budget. It’s done far enough in advance so we can present a complete budget at our annual meeting—scheduled this year for Sunday, February 13, a day before Valentine’s Day.
